# Invoicing and fees.

A session costs £19.80 for half day or £44.60 for an all day. Our funded hours are 8:45-11.45 for morning children. The term after children turn three you are eligible for funding. For all day sessions, the year before school our funding covers 6 hours with a £5 lunch supplement to cover the unfunded 1/2 hour session. There are voluntary contributions for snack, forest and music.

# New happenings

At Pre-School, we are beginning to take a different journey by adopting some of the initiatives from philosophies such as The Curiosity Approach and Hygee. The area that we are creating at Pre-School is one that encourages emotional well-being and friendships. Children can feel comfortable exploring with confidence. With the play-based and child-led approach, children become the lead in their development. The Curiosity Approach uses real open-ended resources, such as loose parts, which can be added to the environment for children to adapt and to turn into anything that they imagine. Children are encouraged and able to explore, experiment, and create, using engaging resources and supported by passionate practitioners. We will also will be changing from our Profiles to a "My Pre-School story". This will be filled with photos and things that your child does at Pre-School. Your child's story will be sent home once a month for your child to draw a picture or for you to add a photo.

### Covid reminder
